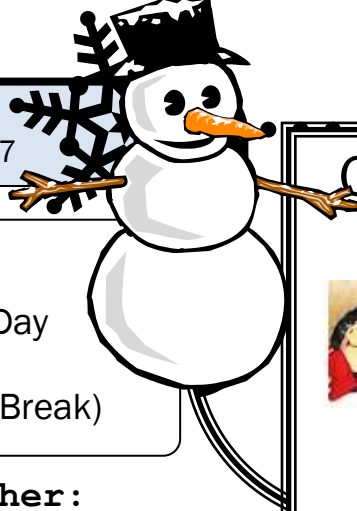


Kindergarten News 2.3.17
